

Guidelines for your conference submission

Your abstract must be submitted online on DFT 2024 secured platform (online form to fill in + PDF 1-page abstract to upload). You will have a chance to edit and modify your contribution until the deadline and you will further have a chance later on to follow their status

Before starting your abstract submission online (exclusively) please remind the instructions:

- The working language at the conference is English and all contributions must be submitted in English.
- Abstracts must be submitted online. Do not fax, mail or email your abstract, as these will not be considered.
- Prepare your 1-page abstract according to the .docx or .tex template (to be downloaded on [DFT 2024 Website – Page Abstracts](#). **Only PDF files** will be accepted – A4-portrait format 210x297 mm - with a max. size of 3 MB, including references, figures and tables. If your file is too large, you should reduce the resolution of the images. Abstract files will be automatically renamed with unique reference number by being uploaded.

- **Scientific papers have to be submitted under one of the 5 following topics:**
 - Methodological Developments in DFT
 - Conceptual DFT
 - Time-dependent approaches in DFT
 - DFT and reactivity
 - DFT and condensed phases

- Please underline the name of the presenting author both for communications and poster presentations.
- When all the materials are ready, please proceed to the "Abstract Submission" by filling online the form and attaching the PDF 1-page abstract
- All modifications – in the submission form and to replace the attached PDF document - will be possible directly on the online abstract submission page until the **abstract submission deadline: March 13th, 2024**.

VERY IMPORTANT: Accepted presentations will be definitively programmed, and the abstract will be included in the book of abstracts only after full registration AND payment of the presenting author before 31 May 2024.

Evaluation rules:

Submitted abstracts are evaluated by DFT 2024 Scientific and Organizing Committees. They will give the final advice about the acceptance of the submitted abstract and the final decision on the assignment of the presentation type; and they will decide to allocate the proposed presentations into the adequate session in order to build up a coherent scientific program.
